DROP-OFF and PICK-UP

Drop off and pick up will be done outside the door. After being dropped off, the counselors will bring them inside. If someone other than parents or designated alternative is to pick up the child, we must have written permission. Please pick up the children promptly at the end of camp. *There is a late fee if a child is not picked up on time*

DRESS

Send the children in play clothes that they can manage by themselves in the bathroom. Shorts and T-shirts are fine – dress for indoor and outdoor play. **Gym shoes and socks are necessary for the playground** – please no sandals, flip-flops, or Crocs. Please send a change of clothes in your child's backpack.

SUNSCREEN -Please apply sunscreen to your child ***before*** he or she comes to Summer Club.

BATHROOM POLICY- All children who attend Summer Club must be toilet trained and self-sufficient in the bathroom (no diapers, pull ups, or "potty seats"). We cannot help them clean themselves either. We will assist with clothing if needed.

Children who have repeated accidents will be asked to withdraw from the program.

LUNCH: Children who attend on Monday, Wednesday and Friday need to bring their own peanut free lunch or snack and drink every day.

SNACKS: Children should bring their own snack every day along with a water bottle. Snack should be a small amount of one item in a small baggie or container, or an individually wrapped package.

BEHAVIOR EXPECTATION

To provide the best possible summer, we will provide consistent rules and expectations for the children. We will use positive and consistent guidance. If a child has repeated difficulty in obeying the rules, we will contact the parents. If the behavior persists, it may result in suspension.
